Every child needs loving parents who EXPECT THE BEST from them at home and at school.

Every child needs parents who love each other. It's healthy for children to see their parents hug each other.

Each child needs some undivided, focused ATTENTION from each parent every day. This means you and the child are together and you are not doing or thinking about anything else. You may be playing together, doing chores together, singing song, or reading but you are CLOSE and CONNECTED TO EACH OTHER.

Every child needs parent who love enough to say NO and know enough to

not try to substitute things for love.

Every child needs parents who love enough to give the child RESPONSIBILITIES around the house.

And finally every child needs daily demonstrations of this love which means HUGS AND KISSES liberally applied as often as possible.
